How are the Candid Seals of Transparency (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum) determined?

• Seals of Transparency are ultimately determined by the amount of information a nonprofit organization shares beyond what is listed in their 990.

Can I search for nonprofit organizations outside of Stanislaus County?

- This Nonprofit Directory currently includes all nonprofits operating within Stanislaus, San Joaquin, and Merced counties.
- A nationwide search can be done using Candid's public database at www.candid.org.

Why can't I find the nonprofit organization I'm looking for, even though they are part of Stanislaus, San Joaquin, or Merced counties?

- Oftentimes spelling errors are the culprit. Double-check the spelling of the organization.
- If the organization you are searching for is a subsidiary of a larger parent organization, it's likely they will not show up due to not being registered independently with the IRS.
 - Ex: Jessica's House, located in Turlock, is part of Emanuel Medical Center. Emanuel Medical Center is registered with the IRS, Jessica's House is not.
- If you are searching for a church or religious organization, they will not show up in the directory unless they are registered with the IRS. Churches often are tax-exempt organizations and automatically receive a tax-exempt status without having to register with the IRS.
