Trinitas Farming Continues Investing in Education Through Stanislaus Community Foundation

Modesto, CA – (October 26, 2018) **Trinitas Partners, LLC**, announced today it would make a sizable investment into the *Stanislaus Futures* Scholarship Fund, administered by Stanislaus Community Foundation.

In January 2016, Trinitas Partners established the Trinitas Farming Scholarship, "*Trinitas-Caritas*," to support the educational and skills advancement of its employees and their families. "We quickly decided that we wanted to widen the scope and help more locals working in the ag industry," recounts Ryon Paton, co-founder and partner at Trinitas Partners. "So we established the Trinitas Farming *Community* Scholarship, open to all Stanislaus County residents who are ag employees, along with their children and grandchildren."

Trinitas Farming has awarded scholarships to 10 students – majoring in everything from business to TV production and attending schools as far away as Kentucky – since 2016. "This was a great start, but it felt like we could do more," commented Allison Hoiberg, Vice President of Sales and Marketing at Trinitas Farming. "We are huge proponents of college education and recognize its many benefits. Stanislaus Community Foundation does a terrific job of extending our reach to find candidates who've worked hard and developed great plans, but could really use some financial assistance, as well as some additional guidance."

When Trinitas management learned of SCF's *Stanislaus Futures* Scholarship Campaign they immediately committed to investing. "*Stan Futures* provides low-income Stanislaus County students the opportunity to achieve their college and career goals," said Josh Kaufmann, Stanislaus Community Foundation's Director of Development. "We have hundreds of students with the ability and desire to succeed in college, but lack access to financial resources and guidance to manage the transition from high school to college. Stanislaus Community Foundation engages our partners to help provide that important guidance, and we are very excited to have Trinitas contribute to this initiative."
